MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Welcome Back

As all holidays seems to do, the midyear vacation passed by very quickly. It is good then, that third term is always an exciting one to look forward to. Our Japanese sister school, Otemon Gakuin Elementary, from Osaka, will begin their visit on Friday, 21 July. A busy program includes, homestays, classroom visits and an excursion to Paradise Country. Our guests will depart on Wednesday 26 July. This year's visit is particularly significant because it marks 25 years since the first visit by Otemon representatives. Among the visiting group of teachers will be Nobu Katsura who was one of those first representatives. It is great too, that Kevin Olive will also be here to welcome our guests. Kevin, with Cathy Politics and Len Homes, were the key advocates of the program here 25 years ago.

As always, a key part of the success of this program has been the homestay component. I would like to thank very much those who have volunteered to host.

A very important event for this term is our Excellence Expo, held on 6 September. We define excellence in learning as doing your best. The night gives an opportunity for the community to come into the school to look at the learning that our students have achieved.

Our study tour to Japan to repay the visit from our sister school will depart on 13 September. This tour is run every second year and has become very popular among our students, parents and staff. Matt Gibney will also be at Otemon at the time of our visit taking part in our teacher exchange.

However, with the cooler weather, I am seeing quite a lot of jackets and jumpers worn, more with an eye to a fashion statement than the necessity to keep warm. I would really appreciate your support in ensuring that the uniform is worn well. The uniform shop is at your disposal to help if needed.

Bringing personal technology devices to school, including mobile phones, is not encouraged. Mobile phones and other recording devices have been subject to theft and inappropriate use, including cyber bullying. Important messages can be passed to and from students through our office, if needed. If, however, parents deem it necessary for their child to have a phone with them, perhaps for example, to coordinate pickups from outside school after hours' activities, students may bring a phone but this phone MUST remain off and in the student's bag while they are on site. Students who infringe this policy will be subject to disciplinary consequences up to and including suspension. Students may choose to have the administration office look after their phone while at school. In addition, parents may want to consider the appropriateness of a primary aged child having unsupervised, after school use of a phone with full social media and recording capability.

Seven Steps to Writing Success involve a technique of teaching children how to write by using a chunking method found in sport. Consider how we learn to play tennis. First we learn the individual skills - forehand, backhand, serve, volley and smash. Then we practise the skills over and over until they go into 'muscle memory'. Finally, we put the skills together to play a game.

According to Jen McVeity, the author of Seven Steps, this technique has become so popular and successful that teachers in one-third of Australian schools are now using the Seven Steps. Jen suggests using the following top tips when creating a Sizzling Start in writing, to help grab hold of students' energy and creativity.

TOP TIP #1: Remember, the task of the first paragraph is to make the reader want to read the **second** paragraph. And then the third, fourth and fifth etc. Keeping this in mind helps the writer focus on making a start 'Sizzle'!

TOP TIP #2: Start with a Sizzling Start and then backfill the who, what, when, where and why as the action unfolds. In other words, start at the 'moment of change'.

TOP TIP #3: Creative writing is about ideas, exploration and discovery. After writing, students should share their favourites with a small group (2-5 students). This allows them to: 1. Analyse their own work, to decipher which one they like the best 2. Receive feedback from others on how well they have done 3. Explore other concepts and ideas through listening to fellow students' work 4. Practise their critical thinking and editing skills.

TOP TIP #4: Use small groups and gameshow-style activities to create a sense of rivalry and excitement whilst also engaging students. Verbal is also a vital part of the curriculum, and must not be overlooked.

TOP TIP #5: Sizzling Starts can incorporate many of the other techniques from the Seven Steps as well. That's the wonderful versatility of writing to engage the reader. Sizzling Starts can use tension, dynamic dialogue or visual imagery (show, don't tell) to enhance their impact. **Authors of the week** some examples of 'Show, don't tell' demonstrating visual imagery. Do you agree they make you want to read on?

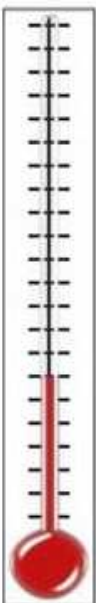

Tax Deductible Building Fund Contribution

Dear HPSS families,

Working with the school, the P&C is undertaking a review of the old dental building near the school oval. We envisage that the additional, transformed space will allow the school's existing programs to extend both in capacity and imagination across multiple disciplines including arts, music, performance and science. We also hope that this space will allow an increase in the capacity for Out of School Hours Care.

The work planned is budgeted to cost \$25,000 and this year we'll be using donations to the HPSS P&C Building Fund to fund this.

We understand that there are a number of demands on family finances, but a modest contribution from school families will go a long way towards realising the potential of this space for our school. A recent project funded by the P&C Building Fund was the remodelling and refresh of the outdoor theatre. We invite you to consider a voluntary, fully tax deductible contribution of \$60 per family (suggested amount) to the P&C Building Fund.


How to contribute:

1. **EFTPOS - Credit/Debit Card:** See over for details.
2. **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT):** See over for details.
3. **Cash:** Place in a sealed envelope and include your name, your child's name and class on the envelope for your tax receipt.
4. **Cheque:** Make Cheques payable to 'Holland Park State School P&C Building Fund' and include your name, your child's name and class on the back of your envelope for your tax receipt.
